

Battle Creek Area Transportation Study (BCATS)

FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - AMENDMENT #5

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REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

THE BATTLE CREEK AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (BCATS) HEREBY GIVES NOTICE of opportunity for public involvement in the fifth amendment to its *Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* for fiscal years (FYs) 2023-2026 (10/1/22–9/30/26), consisting of the following proposed actions:

1) Adding a 2023 capital preventive maintenance (CPM) project to mill and place one course asphalt overlay on I-94BL/M-37 (Columbia Ave W) from Skyline Dr northeastward & eastward to Helmer Rd, by the Michigan Dept of Transportation (MDOT). Total heavy maintenance construction phase (CON) budget \$1,053,000, 100% State of Michigan Betterment "M" funds; *JN-218783.*

2) Abandoning MDOT's planned 2023, \$510,000 CON phase for special pavement marking applications on selected trunklines in MDOT Southwest Region, and reducing the 2023 preliminary engineering (PE) budget by 81.8% to match actual expenditures to date of \$1,818 [90% Federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP), 10% State "M"]; *JN-207367.*

3) Abandoning MDOT's planned 2023 PE and 2024 CON phases to construct an auxiliary right lane on M-66 NB between Beckley Rd and I-94, due to unforeseen roadside drainage issues that would require cost-prohibitive mitigation for this project to move forward. Budget as proposed was for PE \$115,000 (100% State "M") and for CON \$670,000 (81.85% Fed Congestion Mitigation Air Quality, 18.15% State "M"); *JN-210822.*

4) Adding MDOT 2023 PE and 2024 CON phases to install pedestrian crosswalk improvements at six various locations in the MDOT Southwest Region, including in Battle Creek along M-66 (Division St) from the police station driveway just south of the Battle Creek River northward 0.08 mi to Flint St, and along M-66 (Capital Ave NE) from Hopkins St (across from Bailey Park) northward 0.15 mi to J Bartlett Ave. Total budgets for MDOT regionwide project: PE \$155,195 (90% Fed Vulnerable Road Users, 8.75% State "M", 1.25% Local-Cities of Kalamazoo & Battle Creek), CON \$1,119,126 (90% Fed HSIP, 8.75% State "M", 1.25% Local-Cities of Kalamazoo & BC); *JN-218784*.

5) Adding a Vulnerable Road Users Road Safety Audit along 5.3 mi of M-96 (Columbia Ave) from Helmer Rd eastward to Michigan Ave E, to be conducted by MDOT in 2024. Total budget for the safety audit study, considered early preliminary engineering (EPE), \$25,000 (90% Fed HSIP, 8.75% State "M", 1.25% Local-City of BC); *JN-218818.*

6) Adding a Vulnerable Road Users Road Safety Audit along 3.6 mi of M-66 (Division St-Capital Ave NE) from I-194 (at Hamblin/Jackson) north-east-northward to Taylor-Trace just north of Morgan Rd, to be conducted by MDOT in 2026. Total budget for the safety audit study, considered EPE, \$25,000 (90% Fed HSIP, 8.75% State "M", 1.25% Local-City of BC); *JN-218819.*

7) Delaying PE and CON phases of MDOT's planned fixed object removal to the extent of the clear zone along 13.7 mi of M-66 from M-60 in Branch County northward to Glenn Cross Rd. PE moved from 2024 to 2025, PE total budget \$151,292; CON moved from 2025 to 2027 (and out of FY23-26 TIP), due to budgetary restrictions, CON total budget increased 10% to \$652,000 for expected inflation. Both phases funded 90% Fed HSIP, 8.75% State "M", 1.25% Local-City of BC); *JN-218892.*

8) Increasing 2023 Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 operating assistance to Battle Creek Transit (BCT) by 42.2%, to \$2,037,175, matched with \$2,037,175 from the City of BC. Total Fed+Local \$4,074,350, 50% each; *JN-208191.*

9) Abandoning a 2023 FTA Section 5339 capital project to upgrade farebox collection for BCT. Budget as proposed was total \$178,406 [80% Fed FTA-Sec5339, 20% State Comprehensive Transportation Fund (CTF)]; *JN-208238.* and

10) Adding a 2023 FTA-Sec5339 capital project for new communications equipment for BCT. Total \$163,301 (80% Fed FTA-Sec5339, 20% State CTF). *JN-TBD.*
