REQUEST FOR COMMENTS ON TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

THE BATTLE CREEK AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY (BCATS) HEREBY GIVES NOTICE of opportunity for public involvement in the seventh amendment to its *Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)* for fiscal years (FYs) 2023-2026 (10/1/22–9/30/26), consisting of the following proposed additions:

1) 2024 right-of-way (ROW) acquisition for the installation of pedestrian crosswalk improvements by the Michigan Dept of Transportation (MDOT) along M-66 (Division St) from the BC Police Dept entrance just south of the BC River northward to Flint St, and along M-66 (Capital Ave NE) from Hopkins St (opposite Bailey Park) northward to J BartlettAve. Estimated ROW budget \$8,000 [90% Federal Vulnerable Road Users (VRU) program, 8.75% State of Michigan Betterment "M" funds, 1.25% Local-City of Battle Creek]. Estimated \$229,827 construction expected late 2024-2025. *JN-218784.*

2) 2025 *chip seal resurfacing and* tree removal along ~4.0 miles of B Dr S from 8 Mi Rd eastward to 12 Mi Rd in Newton Twp, and *chip seal resurfacing and tree removal* along ~2.0 miles of Struwin Rd from White Rabbit Rd northward to Baseline Rd in Pennfield Twp, by the Calhoun County Road Dept. Estimated construction phase budget \$833,625 (90% Fed High Risk Rural Roads program, 10% Local-Calhoun County). *JN–219875.* (* *strikeout/italic text is correction from published version*)

ing services Perry described reading the "Friends" script for the first time in his memoir, "Friends, Lovers and the Big Terrible Thing."

"It was as if someone had followed me around for a year, stealing my jokes, copying my mannerisms, pho-tocopying my world-weary yet with yoiwe of life. One character in particular stood out to me: it wasn't that I

thought I could 'play' Chandler. I 'was' Chandler." Unknown at the time was the struggle Perry had with addiction and an intense desire to please

"'Friends' was huge. I couldn't jeopardize that. I Prienas was nuge. I couint Jeopardize that. I loved the script. I loved my co-actors. I loved the scripts. I loved everything about the show but I was struggling with my addictions which only added to my sense of shame," he wrote in his memoir. "I had a secret and no one could know." "I felt like I was gonna die if the live audience didn't howeb and they's orth headbh for every But L and

I felt like i was gonna dre in tie nve audernee unan t laugh, and that's not healthy for sure. But I could sometimes say a line and the audience wouldn't laugh and I would sweat and sometimes go into convul-sions," Perry wrote. "If I didn't get the laugh I was sup-posed to get I would freak out. I felt that every single night. This pressure left me in a bad place. I also knew of the cir wonels making that show only to ma of them of the six people making that show, only one of them was sick."

was sick." He recalled in his memoir that Aniston confronted him about being inebriated while filming. "I know you're drinking," he remembered her telling him once. "We can smell it," she said, in what Perry called a "kind of weird but loving way, and the plural "un" hit me like a claderbampurger".

'we' hit me like a sledgehammer." In the foreword to Perry's memoir, Lisa Kudrow de-

scribed him as "whip smart, charming, sweet, sensitive, very reasonable, and rational." She added, "That guy, with everything he was battling, was still there.' An HBO Max reunion special in 2021 was hosted by James Corden and fed into huge interest in seeing the cast together again, although the program consisted of the actors discussing the show and was not a continu-

ation of their characters' storylines.

ation of their characters' storylines. Perry received one Emmy nomination for his "Friends" role and two more for appearances as an as-sociate White House counsel on "The West Wing." Perry also had several notable film roles, starring opposite Salma Hayek in the rom-com "Fools Rush In" on Party also review compared "The Whole Sales In"

and Bruce Willis in the the crime comedy "The Whole Nine Yards.

He worked consistently after "Friends," though nevin a role that brought him as much attention or ac

In 2015, he played Oscar for a CBS reboot of "The Odd Couple" that aired for two seasons. He told the AP that playing Oscar Madison, the character originally made famous in the 1960s series by Walter Matthau, was a "draem role." He also said he was surprised how much he enjoyed being filmed again in front of a live audience

"I didn't realize I missed it really until it actually I don't realize i missed it really until it actuary happened, til we actually shot the pilot and there was a studio audience there and I realized, 'Wow, I really like this. This is nice," he said. "You kind of ham up for the people in the audience. My performance never got bet-ter than when there was an audience there."

blessed by every creative moment we shared." "He was, and I use this term rarely, a genius," Rainn Wilson wrote on Instagram. Chandler was one of the all-time great characters and his ability to spin a slightly funny line into absolute comedy gold was un-surpassed."

Rumer Willis recalled being on the set of "The Whole Nine Yards" and sequel "The Whole Ten Yards" with Perry and her dad, Bruce Willis, "He was so kind and funny and sweet with my sisters and me," she wrote in an Instagram Story. "That movie still makes me laugh so much." Trudeau, who went to school with Perry, posted on

X: "Matthew Perry's passing is shocking and sadden-ing. I'll never forget the schoolyard games we used to play, and I know people around the world are never going to forget the joy he brought them. Thanks for all the laughs, Matthew. You were loved – and you will be missed "
